acid rain

definition:

rain that contains dangerous chemicals (due to smoke from burning fossil fuels that contain sulfur) and that damages trees, crops, buildings, etc.



example:

Acid rain is bad for trees. The acid takes away important minerals from the leaves and the soil. Without these minerals, trees and plants cannot grow properly.
