greenhouse effect



definition:

the warming of the Earth's atmosphere caused by an increase in types of gases in the air surrounding the earth; these types of gases trap the heat of the sun

example:

When fossil fuels such as coal and oil are burned, they release carbon dioxide into the air. This contributes to the greenhouse effect.
